

## STANDARDS AT SCANTABOUT PRIMARY SCHOOL – September 2016

Our analysis of the results at the end of EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 Phonics, end of KS1 and end of KS2 for the academic year 2016 show the following:

### EYFS Results

**82.8%** of pupils reached a Good Level of Development which is higher than Hampshire score of 75.1% pupils and the national score of 69.3% pupils.

### Year 1 Phonics Result

**86.7%** of Year 1 pupils are working at the expected standard for phonics at the end of Year 1 which is higher than the Hampshire score (81.3%) and the national score of (80.5%).

### Year 2 Phonics Result

**100%** children in Year 2 reached the expected standard for phonics at the end of KS1. These children were those who did not achieve the expected standard of phonics at the end of Year 1 and who re-sat the phonic test at the end Year 2. The Hampshire score is 68.7% and the national score is 66.7%.

## End of KS1 Results

### Reading (test result)

**97%** of Year 2 pupils *achieved the expected standard* which is higher than the Hampshire score of 80% pupils and the national score of 74% pupils.

### Writing (teacher assessment result)

**90%** of Year 2 pupils *achieved the expected standard* which is higher than the Hampshire result of 70.3% and the national result of 65.5%.

### Maths (test result)

**93.3%** of Year 2 pupils *achieved the expected standard* in maths which is higher than the Hampshire result of 76.7% pupils and the national result of 72.6% pupils.

### Combined Score in Reading, Writing and Maths – end of KS1

**86.7%** of Year 2 pupils *achieved the expected standard* in reading, writing and maths. This was a higher score than Hampshire score of 65.8% and the national score of 60.3%.

## End of KS2 Results

### Reading (test result)

**71.9%** Year 6 pupils *reached the expected standard* at the end of KS2. This was just above the Hampshire score of 70.9% and significantly above the national score of 65.5%.

### Writing (teacher assessment)

**87.5 %** Year 6 pupils reached the expected standard at the end of KS2. Hampshire's score was 79.9% and the national score was 74%.

### **Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling**

**68.8%** Year 6 pupils reached the expected standard at the end of KS2. This was below the Hampshire score of 74% and the national score of 72.4%.

### **Maths (test result)**

**81.3%** Year 6 pupils reached the expected standard at the end of KS2. This was above the Hampshire score of 71.4% and the national score of 69.7%.

### **Combined Score of Reading, Writing and Maths**

**66%** pupils achieved a combined score for reading, writing and maths compared with the lower score of 57.7% in Hampshire and 53.2% pupils nationally.
